Division 5 Meeting Minutes.

April 3, 2009

Superintendent Al Cap called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm at Hambden Town Hall. Approximately 29 members and 4 guests were present.

It was reported that Division 5 member **Jack Metcalf** recently broke a hip and is in Heather Hill for therapy. He doesn't know how long he will be there.

Railfest went well. We are waiting for the final bills to determine how much we made this year but it looks like it will be a normal year.

The Division 5 table at Railfest sold approximately \$1400 which was lower than past years.

Al Cap reviewed the proposed changes for the Mid Central Region Kingpin that will be discussed at the upcoming MCR BOD meeting.

A new supplier will be used for Division 5 apparel such as shirts and hats. The new supplier does not have minimum order quantities and has a wide range of items that the Division 5 logo can be put on. Mike Buehner volunteered to coordinate getting Division 5 apparel from the new supplier. He will select an assortment of items that can be ordered and create an order form.

Two operating sessions have been scheduled for May. On Saturday, May 9th, we will have an op session on Dave Eggleston's layout. For those interested, Dale Smith may have a possible side trip. On Saturday, May 30th, there will be an op session on Lou Malard's layout. Contact Dale Smith if you are interested in going to either session.

Jim Wendorf has volunteered to be the new Railfest Coordinator.

Matt Kross and Dale Smith announced the name of our 2011 convention. It will be "Rails Of Ages" in celebration of 50 years of railroading in northeast Ohio. There was no winner for the convention name category in our contest. There were winners in the logo and theme categories. The winners will be announced next month. A number of logo ideas were passed around at the meeting for members to provide feedback on.

Treasurer Bonnie Lette read off the various account balances. The Division is solvent and has money in savings.

We are trying to get members to wear their **nametags.** We are going to stop bringing the nametag rack to the meetings. Members are asked to take their nametags home with them and be responsible for wearing them at meetings and events. If anyone needs a new nametag, contact Matt Kross.

HO Module Coordinator Bill Eville reviewed the upcoming HO modular layout setups. The next setup will be at Lake Farmpark in May for Railroads In The Parks.

Division 5 will again be working with Lake Farmpark to put on a Boy Scout Railroading Merit Badge workshop on Saturday, May 2nd, during the Railroads In The Parks event. We will again donate Division 5 HO reefers to use in the workshop. We will need a number of volunteers to help the scouts assemble the car kits and to allow them to run trains on the modular layouts.

No progress to report on **Promo Day 2009** planning. We are having a hard time getting a response from Lakeland Community College about using one of the gyms for the event.

Western Reserve Model Railroad Museum has an open house scheduled for April 18th. The Lionel layout has had its curves broadened so that the Big Boy locomotive now runs reliably. The S gaugers are making a lot of progress on their layout. They have added another dog bone track.

Mike Buehner had a copy of the NMRA New Member Pack CD for anyone that wants it.

Division 5 BOD Meeting Notes

April 20th, 2009

Present: Al Cap, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Don Bittner, Mike Buehner, Matt Kross, Lenny Kessler, Bruce Lutheran, Jim Wendorf, Bill Eville, Bill Brodie, and Harley Smith.

Al Cap reported that Div 5 member Jack Metcalf is still at Heather Hill for therapy for his broken hip.

The dates for **Railfest 2010** are not affected by the updated academic calendar published by Lakeland Community College.

The new **Railfest Committee** has not been formed yet. Jim Wendorf is talking to people to see if they would be interested.

There was discussion again about **Railfest table rates and door fees**. Jim Wendorf will review the costs of Railfest 2009 to see if we need to raise the table fees. We will probably keep the door fee the same.

A motion was passed to require that the **Railfest financial books** be audited within 3 months of the close of the Railfest show, whether or not all bills have been received. For 2009, that means the Railfest audit needs to take place by June 16th.

Division 4 is putting together a bus trip to Cass, WV on October 16-18, 2009. They are opening the trip up to Division 1 and Division 5 members. The trip will cost \$160 and includes the cost of the bus, train ticket, and some meals. The fee does not include the hotel and some of the meals. Information about the trip is available on the Div 4 website.

Division 3 has V&O HO gondola cars for sale.

The Division 5 financial books have been audited through March 2009. No problems were found. Dennis Lloyd is generating an official audit report. A preliminary copy was available for review at the BOD meeting.

It was recommended that whenever a new financial officer is taking office, whether as Division 5 Treasurer or Railfest Chairman, they should attend the final audit of the outgoing officer so that they get an understanding of the requirements of the office and what type of records the auditors expect to see.

Nothing new to report on the new **Division 5 apparel**. Mike Buehner is working on the order form.

Mike Buehner is coordinator for the 2011 convention layout tours. In preparation for the convention, we will be having several layout tours prior to the convention. The first set of tours will be this Fall. Mike has only gotten back two layout surveys so far. He needs members to get these filled out and submitted to him.

The Trainwire copying and postage continues to take a big bite out of the Division 5 budget. We need to get more members to accept the Trainwire electronically.

There was discussion about things we could do to celebrate the **Division's 50th anniversary in 2011.** Don Bittner and Harley Smith think the Division was officially formed in April 1961, but they will need to check that. We think we would like to have some big celebration banquet, but we aren't sure what time of the year would be best to have it. Our convention will be held at the end of April in 2011, so we probably want to hold our special event after that. There was some discussion about sponsoring some special award. We would also like to get pictures of members, layouts, and events throughout our 50 year history.

Matt Kross will finalize the Membership Guide and have it available for our May setup at Farmpark. We will have limited paper copies available for members. An electronic copy will be on the Division website for people to download.

Al Cap stated that he wants to hold a special HO Module meeting to show people that are interested in building a module what is involved and what the guidelines will be. We will probably do this during our module setup at Farmpark May 2-3, 2009. We have some old modules that are available for anyone interested in taking one over. In addition, anyone that wants to build a module completely on their own is now permitted to do so. Bill Eville will provide the module specifications.
