

Dean Freytag 1924 - 2010

Steel mill modeling guru and ardent supporter of the NMRA, Dean Freytag - Master Model Railroader, of Ashland, Ohio, died Christmas Funeral services were held December day. 31st. There will be a memorial service in Ashland towards the end of January.

Dean was a Life member of the NMRA. He served as the National Contest Chairman for many years. He authored the books "The Cyclopedia Of Industrial Modeling" and "The History, Making, & Modeling of Steel". published a large number of "how-to" articles in the model railroad press over the last 50 with over 50 articles in Model vears, Railroader alone. He was a proponent of working with styrene and Plastruct shapes. He was featured in an instructional video about styrene. He had a knack for looking at ordinary household items, such as bottles and caps, and transforming them into realistic items for his models.

Dean was instrumental in getting Walthers to come out with their line of steel mill buildings and accessories. Steel operations dominated Dean's 13' x 28' HO layout, the South Ridge Lines. The NMRA put out a gondola in honor of Dean's Davies Steel company.

Dean came to a number of Division 5 meetings and at least one Christmas party to put on modeling clinics for us.

His knowledge, modeling skills, and promotion of the NMRA will be missed. Rest In Peace Dean.


Bill Berger showed some great pictures of his railfanning in Australia and the British Isles. Bill had a lot of unique shots

The Loser Raffle winners were picked and are posted elsewhere in this Trainwire.







The convention planning is winding down and we are getting ready for the actual convention in a few short months. Here is what we have put together so far:

- We have 26 different one hour clinics scheduled, four 15 minute clinics, plus times set aside for Bring & Brag presentations.
- There are 7 different prototype/industrial tours and six non-rail tours/events.
- 21 layout owners have agreed to have their layouts open for our self-guided layout tours. Several of these layouts will be open for operating sessions on Thursday evening.
- Our banquet speaker will be Rick Rowlands, president of the Youngstown Steel Heritage Foundation that collects and preserves historical elements of the region's steel industry.
- There will be a silent auction, contest room, model display area, company store, and hopefully at least one operating layout at the convention hotel.

We will be trying to add more tours, layouts, clinics, and events up until the time the convention actually starts. If you know of something we can add, let us know, or better yet, volunteer to coordinate the activity.

We have at least 22 early registrations so far with an additional 15 family members signed-up. We expect registrations to pick-up as soon as the convention information packet is received in January by all the Mid Central Region members.

The Early Registration fee of \$45 expires at the end of January at which time the Standard Registration fee of \$60 kicks in. The Division 5 Member Volunteer Registration fee of \$20 will stay the same up to the time of the convention.

Note: You MUST be registered (Volunteer or Regular) to attend the convention activities.

There is a special Div 5 Volunteer Registration form on the Div 5 website and available at the monthly meetings. Your registration now helps us know who will be helping, allows us to plan ahead, and your \$20 registration fee provides us with some funds to purchase the supplies we need to put on the convention.
