Chinese Gift Exchange Rules for the Christmas Party

For those people wishing to participate in the Chinese Gift Exchange, bring a **new or unused model railroad related gift** costing approximately \$15 to the party. Mark on the gift what scale it is such as "HO", "N", "Any", etc.

Note: Only those bringing a gift may participate!

All those participating will draw a number out of a hat. The person with #1 picks a gift from the table, opens it, and shows it to everyone. The person with #2 can then either pick a gift from the table or take the gift from #1. If he takes the one from #1, then #1 gets to pick another gift from the table. The person with #3 can then either pick a gift from the table or take the gift from either #1 or #2. If someone has their gift taken, they get to pick a new one from the table or take one of the gifts from someone else. They cannot take back the gift that was just taken from them! This continues with each person having the choice of either picking a gift from the table or taking a gift from one of the other participants until everyone has a gift. At the end, the person with #1 then gets to trade their gift with any of the other people. If you want, you can bring more than one gift so that you can get additional picks. It is a lot of fun and everyone is encouraged to participate!



December 7, 2012 7:30 pm

Meeting was called to order by Superintendent Rob Bowers at 7:30 pm at Hambden Town Hall. There were 28 members and 5 guests present.

A correction to the November minutes was noted that Assistant Superintendent Dave Neff ran the meeting in the absence of Superintendent Rob Bowers.

Dave Neff provided an update on the NMRA's education program. Weathering will be the first main topic covered. The course modules will cover prototype examples, how to create weathering effects on models, and hands on training.

The HO and N modular layout clubs will again have their layouts set up at Farmpark in December for the Country Lights event. We need Division 5 members to help support these groups.

How do you find out about auctions of model train items"

AuctionZip.com website has listings and you can set up for you to be notified if certain types of items are up for auction. Farm & Dairy paper lists auctions in our area.

Discussed the importance of estate planning as it relates to your model railroad items. A recent auction had equipment from an estate divided into lots that didn't make sense and ended up reducing the amount of money the items were sold for. One example is where steam locomotives were in one lot and a separate lot had the tenders in it.

When probate court sells items in an auction, the people running it have no idea of what items are or what their value is. You need a list of what you have and the approximate purchase value.

• Donations for "The Magic of Scale Model Railroading" Exhibit at the California State Railroad Museum are continuing to pour in. Among the more noteworthy are:

OThe World's Greatest Hobby campaign has pledged \$50,000 toward the Exhibit.

OCincinnati Division 7, in the Mid-Central Region, has pledged \$15,000 toward the Exhibit.

Current pledge and donation totals are now over \$200,000, but the NMRA still needs to raise an additional \$50,000 to meet the \$250,000 "matching challenge pledge" by an anonymous donor. - The Winter Board of Directors Meeting will be held in Atlanta, Georgia, at the Sheraton Suites Galleria-Atlanta, on February 8-10. Although the Board meets in a closed caucus the evening of February 8, the general meeting is open to all NMRA members on February 9 and 10.
- •Hasea.com, the model railroad association located in China which has aligned itself with the NMRA, has invited the NMRA President and a few other NMRA officials to tour the new, highly restricted Chinese High Speed Rail factory and facilities in February. No foreign visitors have ever had the opportunity to view these facilities before. As you may recall from NMRA Magazine articles and blurbs here, Hasea is a network of 100,000 Chinese railfans and modelers. The NMRA Board has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with Hasea to share our standards and organizational knowledge.
- •The <u>Peachtree Express 2013 website has been updated</u>, and now lists all the planned prototype and general interest tours, along with all layout tours.
