

January 21, 2013 7:30 pm

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on January 21, 2013 at Hambden Town Hall. In attendance were Rob Bowers, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Matt Kross, Bob Frieden, Bob Gittinger, and Dave Neff.

Dave Neff presented the list of meeting programs through August along with the Bring & Brag themes for the meetings in 2013. The detailed list will be published in the February Trainwire.

Rob Bowers presented some of the new things that **Railfest 2013** will be offering. Vendors can place orders for box lunches that will be delivered to their tables on Saturday and Sunday so that they don't have to leave their tables for lunch. There will be a buffet dinner Saturday evening in the Lakeland cafeteria for Railfest vendors and exhibitors. For both of these items, advance reservations are required. Another new item is a full page ad in the News Herald that not only contains information about Railfest, but also has copies of the business cards of vendors that will be at the show. The vendors must pay to have their card listed.

A motion was passed to **reward members** that have their original work published on the Division 5 website. The reward will have the same regulations as they are for items published in the Trainwire. A member can only receive one reward for the same material if it is published in both the Trainwire and on the website. For published website material, the level of reward is at the discretion of the Division 5 webmaster. The rules will be published in the February Trainwire and added to the Division 5 Membership Guide.

The Board discussed options for investing the Division 5 savings. A number of possibilities exist and the Treasurer will gather some additional information. The goals for the investment should be: no risk to the principle, a rate of return that at least keeps up with inflation, and portions of the money be readily available if needed for emergencies.

The Board discussed ways we can recognize members for special service to the hobby.

October, we went for drive in part of the Cuyahoga Valley National Park near the tracks of the


