n my home layout--assuming I get past the frenzy of making it presentable for touring associated with National Convention---I the plan to use 2014 as the year in which I install animated signals and crossings. Now I don't know the first thing about how such prototypes operate.....do But I'm learning---vou? currently reading a good book on Railroad Signaling by Brian Solomon, recently re-published in soft cover in 2010 by Voya-

geur Press from the original hard-bound copy in 1966. It is a comprehensive discussion on how signaling technology originated in England, then spread to the fledgling railroad industry in the United States in the 19th century and how we clever Americans adapted concepts for our own usage. Learning the different signal 'aspects' and Rules--which differed from railroad to railroad---is a daunting task. Locomotive engineers had to know their semaphore indications and light patterns very well in order to maintain safe travel on the rails. Manual block, automatic block, centralized traffic control (CTC), train control and cab signaling---it's all there in this book and is a formidable challenge for understanding and comprehension.

Now some of you larger scale modelers may have already conquered this technology with installed and automatic signaling on your layout, and maybe even computerized control to change light patterns and positions. If so-who would like to present a clinic on Signaling Application and Installation on a Model Railroad Layout at a future meeting? I'm sure this would be very valuable and informative to many of us. And fortunately, there are a few clinics being offered at the National Convention this summer by such notables as Bruce Chubb, MMR, sand Gerry Albers (co-operator with Allen McLelland) on Signaling. I'm looking forward to sitting on a couple of these.



Division 5 BOD Meeting

January 13, 2014

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on January 13, 2014 at Hambden Town Hall. In attendance were Rob Bowers, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Matt Kross, Bob Frieden, Bob Gittinger, Tom Pescha, Dave Neff, Ted Wiese, Jim Wendorf, and Don Bittner.

The 2014 budget was updated with the final 2013 expenses and a final quick review was done.

A possible return trip to Scenic Express in Pennsylvania is being considered for a Saturday in April or May.

The old **Division 5 business card** was reviewed and modifications identified. We will get 500 new cards made.

Donations were approved for the Lake Erie N-scale Society and the Lake Shore Live Steamers. \$450 will be donated to LENS towards their purchase of a DCC system for their modular layout. \$200 will be donated to the LSLS towards their Hobo Stew Dinner which Division 5 is invited to in the Fall.

To date, no one has been found that is will to be on the **2014 Nominating Committee**. Because of this, anyone wanting to run for one of the two Division offices will need to submit a petition for the office that has the approval of at least two other Division 5 members. At this point, no one has officially said they are willing to run for office.

We would like to have some **layout tours** this Spring in preparation for the upcoming national convention. We are looking at doing them in the April/May timeframe and splitting up the tours between a Saturday and Sunday as well as staggering the times.

Railfest 2014 status: We have 55 vendors signed up so far with 200 out of 410 tables accounted for. We only have a couple of people signed up for the box lunches and the Saturday dinner. We need people to signup for the dinner now. We will be running the large ad in the News Herald that contains the smaller vendor ads. We have received half (\$2600) of the Lake County Visitor's Bureau grant that must be used for advertising. One of the requirements of this grant is that we have to provide them with a lot of information. Tom Pescha is providing the needed info to them.

The Treasurer has requested a list of all Division 5 events for 2014 that will require an insurance certificate from the NMRA national office listing specific organizations. The two that we know of at this time are Railfest (Lakeland Community College) and Great Lakes Mall Kids Show (ProMart).

The BOD approved Division 5's participation in the Kids Show at Great Lakes Mall on March 22-23. This will be the weekend after Railfest. Setup will be on Friday night with the show hours being 10am - 8pm on Saturday and 11am - 6pm on Sunday. Cost to us will be \$250. Approximately 60,000 people are at the mall during these two days.

Rob Bowers presented a revised set of rules for the proposed diorama contest. The main thing that was changed is to go with the same amount of square feet for every scale. The initial proposal is 5000 square feet in your scale which can be any set of dimensions you desire, such as 100 scale feet by 50 scale feet. This would be a quarterly contest decided by popular vote. Points would be awarded. The person with the most points at the end of the year would win some as-of-yet undetermined prize.

The BOD approved trading a dozen Division 5 FP&E reefers with Division 3 for a dozen of their V&O reefers.

We are going to get more **Division 5 tri-fold fliers** printed. Some updates are needed prior to printing. Matt Kross will make the updates and send to Tom Pescha for printing.

An idea was presented that we give out **NMRA RailPass memberships** at certain events as a method to get targeted individuals interested in our Division and the NMRA. Some pros and cons were discussed. The idea was tabled until the next meeting.

NOTE: The next **Division 5 BOD meeting** will be held at the Denny's restaurant across from the Great Lakes Mall near the Best Buy. The next meeting will be February 10, 2014 at 7:30 pm.
