





















Next Division 5 Meeting September 4, 2016

Division 5 BOD Meeting

August 8, 2016

A **Division 5 BOD meeting** was held on August 8, 2016 at Hambden Town Hall. In attendance were Dave Neff, Bryan Persing, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Matt Kross, Tom Pescha, Don Bittner, Bob Gittinger, Bob Frieden, and Dale Smith.

Discussed holding the **October membership meeting** in Erie, PA. The Lakeshore Model Railroad Association has agreed to host the meeting. It was decided to try and have the meeting on either Saturday or Sunday afternoon. We will need to contact Russ Bova to see what day will work for his group.

An idea was presented to the BOD regarding setting up an optional loan each year to the silent auction committee of the annual NMRA national convention. The silent auction at the national convention is not controlled by the NMRA national office. It is up to the convention host committee whether they want to hold a silent auction and to run it. One of the biggest issues with running a silent auction is having funds available to pay the sellers at the end before the money collected from the buyers is processed by the bank. This requires having a significant sum of money in the bank in order to be able to ride through this period of several weeks. Many host groups don't have the funds available to do this and therefore decide not to hold a silent auction. As a solution to this, it was suggested that Division 5 set up a loan program that would be available each year to the national convention host committee if they wanted to make use of it. The money would be loaned to the group for 4 to 6 weeks. A service charge would be included along with penalty fees for late repayment. Division 5 successfully did this with this year's silent auction committee for the 2016 NMRA national convention. If the idea is pursued, we would need to get a lawyer to review the plan and draw up a contract template. Based on experience from the last couple years of national silent auctions, the loan amount would need to be on the order of \$20,000. This would be a direct transaction between Division 5 and the convention host committee. The NMRA national office would not be involved. The idea was tabled for further discussion at upcoming Division 5 BOD meetings.

There is still some confusion regarding which MCR division the former **Allegheny Highlands Division members** have been transferred to. Some misinformation was published that indicated people in the Warren, PA area are part of Division 5. As of the moment, the new counties added to Division 5 have not changed. They are Crawford and Erie counties in PA, and Chautauqua county in NY. Any additional members would only be added by zip code for a specific area if all the NMRA members in that zip code agreed on joining Division 5. MCR President Steve Kaplan is making sure this is clear with everyone.

With new counties having been added to Division 5, it was suggested that now might be the time to discuss changing the **monthly membership meeting location**, day, and time. The BOD discussed various issues involved with this. It was decided to table this for now and see what level of participation we have from the members in the new counties.

Information was received from **Atheam** regarding their support of special run cars. They are open to doing it but they can only do it when they are doing a production run. The minimum quantity is 400 cars. They generally have the same car in both HO and N, so either scale is an option.

It was noted that **NMRA national office** had a large number of railroad car kits donated to them for use in Boy Scout Railroading Merit Badge workshops. They are free but divisions have to submit a specific request to get them. It was suggested we request kits to support next year's workshop.

Cost to the Division for the Medina, NY trip was \$2,024.

The next regular **Division 5 BOD** meeting will be September 12, 2016 at 7:30pm at Hambden Town Hall.
