Superintendent's Report

MCR Update

ust returned from the Mid Central Regional, so here's a quick report:

Registrations 367, including 90 spouses, and they had a great time with their programs The number of total registrants is a modern record for the MCR!

Division 5 members in attendance: Craig Potter, Jim McCullom, Mike Rudder, and Rich and Linda Kacprzak in addition to myself.

The clinic program was excellent, including Allen McLelland giving one his new V & O Alloy Division which resides in Gerry Albers' Deepwater District Railroad. Other good clinics included model finishing techniques, Scratch building in the Digital Age (3d printing) given by new MMR Steve Zapytowski of Division 1, among others. I Toured Gerry's layout once again (I had a private tour and ran a locomotive on it 4 years ago). Also visited well known long time author Jerry Strangarity's layout (many articles on scratch built structures in the 70's).

The MCR BOD meetings including several national officers, Mike Brestel (former president), Charlie Getz (outgoing president), Pete Magoun (incoming president), Gerry Leone VP Special Projects, Frank Koch (Chief Financial Officer) and Christina Gardner (Marketing Manager).

Business discussed at the BOD included need to step up communications on the Division level regarding the partnership program (vendor discounts to NMRA members). Also, new focus on T-Trak on all levels as a means of getting younger folks into the hobby (not kids, but 20-30 somethings who have money but no space for a full layout); good way to get them started. Will discuss further at future Division meetings. Insurance coverage can now be increased above \$1,00,000 if need be (not pertinent as yet to our Division, but definitely affecting Division 11 for Mall Shows). Also a need to further emphasize on the Division level how to gain access and use the 'members only' pages/services on the national website (will discuss at a future meeting).

I discussed ideas for new clinics/programs with several others and we are proceeding with a clinic exchange list between Divisions 1, 4, 5 and 12 for members to attend other Divisions to give programs.



Asst. Superintendent: Bryan Persing




