## **Division 5 Loses Another Legend**


n Thursday, July 12, 2018 Donald M. Bittner slipped the bonds of this world and entered the Kingdom of the Lord. Don was born April 7, 1931 in Painesville and lived in Mentor for over 60 years. graduated as an apprentice auto mechanic from the Cleveland Trade School in 1950 and honorably served in Korea (1951-1953) for the United States Army as an aircraft mechanic. Don's career revolved around his love for automobiles. He was a mechanic for Barton **Brothers** Garage Painesville, and the general manager McClintock Chevrolet in Chardon, as well as one of the first instructors (in 1966) at the Lake County Joint Vocational School, now known as Auburn Career Center. He owned his own business restoring historical vintage race cars for several years, then took a position with the City of Mentor as an Equipment Maintenance Supervisor, retiring in 1993. Post retirement, he and his wife traveled over

160,000 miles, through 42 states with their camper. He had a lifelong passion for trains and was a proud member of the National Model Railroad Association - Division 5, where he earned several awards for his modeling craftsmanship and volunteer activities. Don is survived by his wife of 64 years, Nancy (Steinbrick); daughters, Teri Bittner and Sally (Bob) Rynazewski; and granddaughters, Sara Rachel Rynazewski.



The First Painesville Train Station was built in 1850 for the Cleveland, Painesville and Ashtabula Railroad. The first train ran from Painesville to Cleveland on November 20, 1851. The trip took about 2 1/2 hours. The alternate form of travel was a 14 hour, once per week stagecoach ride, horse back or walking.

The present Painesville Depot was Built in 1893 under the Lake Shoe and Michigan Southern Railroad (LS&MS). The LS&MS railroad merged with the New York Central Railroad in 1914. This Station served as a passenger station until 1971 when Amtrak was formed.

The Western Reserve Railroad Association, doing business as The Painesville Railroad Museum, received ownership of the station in 1997.




The Cassandra Cut in Pennsylvania.
