

The Division 5 and Railfest 2018 financial audits are scheduled to be performed on August 21, 2018.

The **Boy Scout Railroading Merit Badge workshop** is all set for September 15, 2018. Thirty HO railroad car kits and sets of couplers have been ordered from Stewarts Hobbies.
