

My Visit to Kinzua Bridge State Park - Railroad Bridge Update

hile on a camping trip to North West Pennsylvania last year, we decided to stop at Kinzua state park and visit the Kinzua railroad bridge, or as it is now known as, the kinzua skywalk. Many years ago, my family took the Knox-Kane railroad trip, which was a very nice scenic railroad trip on a Chinese steamer, which went round trip to the Kinzua Bridge, including going over and back on the bridge. We as many of you know, the bridge was once the longest and tallest railroad bridge at 2053 feet long and 301 feet high, it was hit by a tornado in 2003 and partially destroyed. The

remainder was turned into the state park back in 2011. Always taking advantage of reviewing a railroad bridge, especially one that I once road all the way across, was an opportunity that I had to review. As you can see from the following pictures, the beauty still lives:



he picture at the left shows the bridge at eye level. You can walk out onto the bridge and look out into the valley, but, I will tell you the height may bother some people. At the end is a piece of Plexiglas that you can stand on a look straight down, and yes, it is plenty sturdy. The next shot, shown from the left and a little below, shows a good perspective of what the whole bridge once looked like, with the bridge supports (towers) scattered.



The next shot shows the bridge from the right, and if you look at the far end of the photo, you will see the steel supports that remain standing, on what used to be the far side of the bridge.




This shot shows the above in more detail,





path down to the bottom of the valley; however, my wife did not want to take the long hike that day. The visitors center is very up to date, with many display models of the before and after of the bridge, and its history. So the next time you are in North West Pennsylvania, just south

of Bradford (famous for the Zippo lighter museum), enjoy a nice day reviewing a great piece of railroad history. - Bruce Lutheran


