

Division 5 BOD Meeting

June 10, 2019

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on June 10, 2019 at Hambden Town Hall. In attendance were Mike Buehner, Bryan Persing, Bonnie Lette, Matt Kross, Bob Gittinger, Ray Newnes, Ted Wiese, Chuck Limbert, and Mike Carovac.

Discussed how the BOD will handle "emergency requests" for Division assistance that may come up. The requests we have received in the past are from groups for financial assistance. The Superintendent wants there to be 100% agreement by BOD members for something like this. In "rush" situations, e-mail is usually used to get BOD feedback and votes. A number of BOD members do not like holding these discussions via e-mail. BOD needs to come up with a set of rules to use for these types of e-mail discussions. One proposed rule is that we want 100% of BOD voting members to respond before any action is taken via e-mail responses. More thought and discussion is needed on this topic.

August Division membership meeting will be held at the **home of Bill Osborne** for an outdoor railroad movie night. People should be informed to bring a chair and warm clothes. Pizza will be provided by the Division.

Boy Scout Railroading Merit Badge Workshop will be held on September 14 from 10am to 4pm at the Painesville Depot. Gary J. is forwarding information about the workshop to the local BSA Council. Coordinator Phil B. has the 30 cars that Lake Farmpark returned to us. Farmpark has decided that they will not be holding a similar workshop in the Spring like they have been and it will probably be a while before they start them again. The fee per scout will be \$25 and limited to 20 scouts. Ted W. will look into sources for cars for future workshops. Phil B. is checking with Scale Trains to see if they are still donating cars for this purpose.

Division 5 Model Railroad Promotional Day or "How To Build A Model Railroad" will be held at the Painesville Depot this year on November 2. There is concern about the limited space that will be available. We may need to rethink what demonstrations we will have available. There won't be any extra layouts brought in for display. Just the layouts already at the Depot will be on display. It was suggested that it would be nice to have a small T-Trak layout on display to show a unique way to get started in model railroading. It was also suggested that we have some home layouts open that day for viewing. Another suggestion was that we have some sort of hands-on assembly of T-Trak modules and allow visitors to "experiment" with them by trying to do some wiring and scenery.

Meeting programs are needed for **September through December**.

Tentative date for the Holiday Party will be Saturday, **January 11, 2020.**

Bonnie L. will get insurance certificates for the BSA merit badge workshop and Promo Day.

Old Business: Still need to finalize the membership survey we said we were going to do. Chuck L. will resend the draft he created to the BOD for review.

The next scheduled **Division 5 BOD meeting** will be August 12, 2019 at 7:30pm at Hambden Town Hall.


