



NMRA Convention 2019

attended this year's convention held in Salt Lake City July 7-13. The hotel, Little America, was very elegant but not flashy, the accommodations, food and service were superb, as was the several rooms designated for clinics and other functions. Our own Wayne provided the software for operating the Silent Auction, and the auction chairman was quite pleased with its functionality and ease of operation. NMRA has used Wayne's program in all but one of the past conventions since we co-hosted in 2014. As usual, there were many good clinics to choose from, including one that I intend to reprise a bit and deliver to our Division sometime this Fall on 'Terminating Turnout Troubles' (my title).


The National Train show was held at an event center 25 minutes away by light rail, and everyone received a pass to go there and back by train. Most of the usual manufacturers were represented, and there was plenty of 'stuff' for sale in both HO and N scales. I picked up a great new product and will briefly detail its use and application in Bring n Brag at our September meeting. There were several interesting layouts in all scales----including TT, T-Trak, NTrak, HO, Lego, S and O scale, and a huge Free-moN layout with over 200 individual modules supplied by several Pacific Coast state clubs. Another very interesting display was comprised of nearly 50 individual 'Pizza Box Modules' built by elementary school kids. This is a program that originated in last year's convention in Kansas City and is growing. We'll be talking about it at our Division meetings as another way to get kids involved (also attracts adult interest) and continue to fulfill our mission to both educate and entertain.


I attended one layout tour featuring a D&RG HO setup, and an N Scale Milwaukee road theme; both were superb nearly complete full-basement layouts. Another interesting tour took us to Promontory point (see accompanying pix) to visit the site of the driving of the Golden Spike 150 years ago in 1869. Several tour visitors among us participated in the ceremonial re-enactment.


