By now, we all know Division 4's Great Berea Train Show was cancelled. The Erie show on November 1<sup>st</sup> has been cancelled. More and more upcoming but tentative train shows have been cancelled. The Division 5 BOD has decided not to hold any in-person events through the end of the year, so this means our November Promo Day is cancelled and the October, November, and December membership meetings will be held virtually using Zoom. We have also cancelled our annual Holiday Party that we hold in early January and cancelled the annual Losers Raffle that we conduct at the party. At the moment, even Railfest 2021 in March is looking iffy, but this will mainly depend on whether Lakeland Community College will allow any shows in the gyms by then. We may have to look at holding Railfest sometime during the summer, assuming the situation improves.

scale Society (LENS) did in early September. A number of LENS members had items they wanted to sell and there were other members looking to buy various items. 

# MINUTES

### SEPTEMBER BOD

#### BOD Meeting 14 Sep 2020

A virtual Division 5 BOD meeting was held on September 14, 2020 via online meeting using Zoom. In attendance were Matt Kross, Mike Carovac, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Ray Newnes, Linda Kacprzak, Tom Pescha, Ted Wiese, and Bryan Persing.

- Due to the current state of Covid-19 in the local area as of the time of the BOD meeting and the current limitations on the Painesville Railroad Museum, it was decided to cancel our 2020 Promo Day planned for Saturday, November 7.
- It was also decided not to have any Division in-person meetings for the remainder of the year. Therefore, the October, November, and December membership meetings will be done virtually online using Zoom.
- Tom Pescha reported that holding Railfest 2021 in March is looking doubtful. Lakeland Community College had a major layoff of personnel which included the people we normally deal with for Railfest. We don't know if they are accepting any reservations for events in 2021. We are still trying to contact someone who may be able to provide the needed answers. The college currently does not have any food service. We might be able to hold Railfest later in the year.
- The BOD decided to set the 2021 Division 5 Budget to be the same as this year's with one exception. Due to our lack of income in 2020, we will not budget any money for grants in 2021. Since we did not have any income in 2020, funding for the 2021 budget will have to come out of savings.
- Due to the extraordinary events this year, the BOD decided to extend the expiration date on all 2020 Division 5 certificates by one year. Any certificate with a 2020 expiration date will now be valid until 2021.
- The BOD decided to forego trying to perform our annual financial audits this year and instead wait until the Summer of 2021 and audit two years worth.
- The Division Holiday Party in early January has been cancelled. Also, the Losers Raffle that is held during the Holiday Party is also cancelled. We only had two months (February and March) in 2020 where we sold raffle tickets at meetings. We will combine the losing raffle tickets from 2020 with those from 2021 when we do the Losers Raffle in January of 2022.
- The next Div 5 BOD meeting will be on Monday, November 9, 2020, at 7:30pm online using Zoom. (Note: Normally, BOD meetings are held on even numbered months from February to October and then in November and not in December.)

Railfest 2021 status is unknown at this time. The Division BOD will discuss this at their September 14<sup>th</sup> meeting.

The Division 5 BOD will meet on September 14, 2020. The following will be agenda topics: Promo Day 2020, October Div 5 meeting, Losers Raffle, Holiday Party, 2021 Budget, Railfest 2021, and 2020 Division certificates.

There will be a Mid Central Region virtual BOD meeting at the end of October.

#### **Zoom Meeting Instructions**

#### **Getting Started**

Up to 15 minutes before the meeting is scheduled to start, click on the link you were provided for the Zoom meeting or type it into your web browser.

If you have not used Zoom before on your computer, you will be instructed to download the Zoom application. You need to do this but it doesn't take very long.

Zoom will ask for or show your default name. Enter your name so we know who you are.

You have an opportunity to test your audio at this point by clicking on "Test Computer Audio." Once you are satisfied that your audio works, click on "Join audio by computer."

You will be placed in a waiting room until the meeting host allows you to join the meeting. This is why we need to know who you are.

#### Once You Are Connected

At the bottom of your screen you should see the following participant controls:



#### Mute/Unmute your microphone

Start/Stop Video – turns your webcam on or off

View Participant list – opens a pop-out screen that includes a "Raise Hand" icon that you may use to raise a virtual hand. You can also change your screen name that is seen in the participant list and video window.

Chat allows you to type text messages to meeting participants

Somewhere on your Zoom screen you will also see a choice to toggle between "speaker" and "gallery" view. "Speaker view" shows the active speaker. "Gallery view" tiles all of the meeting participants.

#### **General Instructions**

If you want to be heard during the meeting, you need to make sure your microphone is Unmuted. Normally, you should leave your microphone muted so that background noises (dogs barking, TV, phone ringing) are not picked up. At times in the meeting, the host may mute all participants to eliminate background noise.

You do not have to turn on your webcam (Start Video). If you do, the other meeting participants will see you which is nice during the social time. But, you can leave it off and a blank box with just your name will be seen by the others.

Gallery View displays all the meeting participants on one screen. The box of the person talking will be highlighted in yellow. Speaker View shows a full screen view of the current person speaking.

#### **During The Meeting**

Mute your microphone unless you have something to say

Do not share your screen unless instructed to by the host

Unruly or unwelcome participants can be kicked out of the meeting by the host

Ask questions using the Chat box. The presenter will periodically check these.

Be aware that the meeting may be recorded.

Spend the day railfanning, Food will be available for small donation.



### **Scrap Metal Loads Waiting To Go To The Steel Mill**

I bought a bunch of plastic and resin scrap metal loads recently along with a couple of steel mill ladles. I "rusted" them using the Sophisticated Finishes products that I showed at a previous Division 5 meeting. The Iron Metallic Surfacer is a thin film that contains actual iron particles ground very fine. The Rust Antiquing Solution is applied to the dried film of iron particles to give a realistic rust color.
