

My Past Month Modeling Work

I slacked off a bit this past month in my model work. I didn't really get much done on my layout due to the holidays and other things going on. One thing I have been working on lately is installing Caboose Hobbies N scale ground throws for the turnouts in my yards and industrial areas. I had planned to install small slide switches to control the manual turnouts and would still like to do this someday. However, I haven't found a guick and easy way to install and connect the slide switches. It takes me a long time to install a slide switch for just one turnout. Thus, it isn't something that I like to do and I have only installed about five of the seventy some that I need to do, and that is over a period of many years! There was a sale on the Caboose Hobbies ground throws so I decided to get those since they were much easier and quicker to install. The problem with them is that they are so large in N scale that you can't hide them. I started installing these in my Maeport Yard and was able to get 17 installed in a couple of evenings. They may be a bit large and unsightly, but at least now I can use one of my yards without using pins to hold the turnout positions in place.




