

MINNUTES

Division 5 Membership Meeting Minutes November 4, 2022

The November 4, 2022, membership meeting was held at Hambden Township Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Superintendent Matt Kross. 16 members and one guest were present.

October Division 5 layout tours were poorly attended by Division 5 members.

- The Division is putting together a trip to visit the Western Pennsylvania Model Railroad Museum in Gibsonia, PA. An electronic survey was e-mailed to Division members to determine what dates would work the best. The plan is to carpool. We will leave around 9am and return around 6pm. Final details will be in the December Trainwire and e-mailed to members.
- If you are not receiving the Division survey e-mails, contact the webmaster. Make sure your e-mail address listed on the Division 5 members only section of the website is the correct e-mail address. There is a problem with some e-mail providers not delivering messages that they think is spam. We do not have any control over that.
- We will be having a Division Holiday Party on Saturday, January 7, 2023. The location still needs to be finalized but most likely will be Hambden Town Hall. Dennis Lloyd volunteered to be the party co-ordinator.
- Reviewed the status of Division 5 Railfest 2023 planning. Everything is still on track. Invitations to dealers will not be sent out until the end of November which is our standard schedule. Table prices were raised by \$1. The gate price will stay the same since it has already been published. Reviewed schedule of upcoming local train shows and events.
- At the December membership meeting, we will have a presentation on the 2023 MCR convention which will be held in Cranberry Township, PA, just north of Pittsburgh.
- Reviewed some of the highlights of the October Division 5 BOD meeting. Minutes of the meeting were published in the November Trainwire.
- We are going to do a survey of the membership to see if members want to change the day/time that we hold our monthly meetings. At this point, we are just trying to gage the members' desires. No changes are currently planned.
- We have meeting programs through at least February 2023. We have a couple of potential programs but are always looking for more to fill out the year. If you have a program you can present at a monthly meeting, please contact Mike Carovac.
- Submissions for the Trainwire are always needed and welcomed. You can write about a convention you went to, a layout or museum you visited, a modeling technique you tried, a new product you used, etc.
- The Mod Squad 3-rail O modular layout group thanked the Division for the grant we awarded them several years ago that helped them get started. Membership in their group is really growing and they are doing a lot more setups at train shows.

Division 1 is going to implement both N and HO versions of T-Trak modules.

BOD Meeting 14 Nov 2022

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on November 14, 2022. The meeting was held online using Zoom. In attendance were Matt Kross, Mike Carovac, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Linda Kacprzak, Dennis Lloyd, and Chuck Limbert.

Contract with Lakeland Community College has been signed for Railfest 2023.

We will try to have a Zoom presentation on the MCR 2023 Convention at the December meeting. Meeting programs are in place through April 2023.

- Survey results for best date to go to the Western Pennsylvania Model Railroad Museum indicated that Saturday, December 3, 2022 was best. Plan is to carpool from the Walmart parking lot in Chardon and meet at a fast-food place near the museum, have lunch, and then proceed to the museum. Details will be in the December Trainwire.
- Holiday party planning is in process. Date is set for Saturday, January 7, 2023. Still determining where it will be held. The event will be free for each Division member and one guest. Social time will start at 12:00pm, meal will start at 1:00pm, program will start around 2:00pm. We will need members to RSVP by mid-December so that we have a count for food. We are looking at some program alternatives. We will still have the Losers Raffle but will not have the Chinese Gift Exchange.
- Suggested that we look into the Geauga Park District activities to see if we can somehow be included to set up a train display for one of their events. The even would need to have some relationship to trains and have enough people attending, especially kids, to make our display worthwhile. The event would have to have a facility with enough room for us to set up a layout or display.
- A number of other MCR divisions were having an online discussion about the benefit of having a test track at their division table. The most successful test tracks had many different scales and control systems. Division 5 may want to consider building such a test track. This could be a Division construction project and teaching experience.
- Along with the test track discussion, divisions were also discussing experiences where dealers were taking advantage of young or inexperienced model railroaders and selling them "junk". Some divisions were wondering if they should put together a guide for parents and new model railroaders with tips on what to look for when buying used trains. This discussion of a guide opened up all sorts of issues. The main overall result of the discussion was that a convenient test track at a show will help people see if the item they want to buy works or not.

- Bonnie Lette and Linda Kacprzak talked to the Thompson, OH library manager about the possibility of holding our Division 5 Model Railroad Promotional Day there. He was very open to the idea and indicated what space in the library they could make available for us to use. Some advantages of holding Promo Day there are: it would be free to use, they would do free advertising for us through the Geauga County Library publications, nice new facility with plenty of parking, and we would draw people from a different area than our previous events. The library would still be open for normal business from 9am to 5pm so there are a few restrictions such as not blocking access to the various bookshelves but they have no problem with the noise level that would occur from all the clinics going on. There is enough space that we could have about 9 clinic stations along with various displays and a small T-Trak layout. To use their advertising, we need to have information to them by about April if we are holding our event in November. It was also mentioned that the Bainbridge, OH library was even more space and could be a possibility in the future. We will need to make a decision on this at our February BOD meeting. We may want to reconsider when we hold our Promo Day. We have typically held the event on the first Saturday in November but this is not a requirement and November is turning into a very busy month. We will tentatively target mid-October 2023 for our next Promo Day.
- The Division 5 brochure needs to be updated and copies made. We need to provide copies to the LENS and Mod Squad modular groups for them to have available. We need to do a better job of keeping track of leftover Div 5 brochures and other promotional materials when tearing down after a show. We keep losing our extra copies. Need to make the membership aware of this problem.
- Still need to put out a survey to the membership to see if there is a desire to change the monthly meeting day/time. We will wait until we get the feedback from the survey to see if we want to try changing when we hold our monthly membership meeting. If we have our meetings on Saturday or Sunday afternoons, there are alternative meeting locations we could use.
- The next Div 5 BOD meeting will be on Monday, February 13, 2023 at 7:30pm online using Zoom. (Note: Normally, BOD meetings are held on even numbered months from February to October and then in November and not in December.)

Warning: In order to view the museum's layout, a lot of walking is involved. Also, you will need to walk up a flight of stairs to get to the upper floor where the layout is located. We might be able to drive you around the building to the upper entrance to eliminate the stairs. Date: Saturday, December 3, 2022 Where: Western Pennsylvania Model Railroad Museum 5507 Lakeside Drive Gibsonia, PA 15044 Times: Meet at Chardon Walmart parking lot between 9:00am and 9:30am Leave from Chardon Walmart parking lot at 9:30am Meet at McDonalds on PA Rt. 8 just north of the turnpike at 11:45am (McDonalds, 200 Walmart Drive, Gibsonia, PA 15044) Arrive at museum at 1:00pm Leave museum around 3:00pm Arrive back in Chardon around 5:30pm Museum fees: Adult \$10; Child \$5 Cost: Division 5 will reimburse \$5 for a member and \$5 for one guest either before or after entry to the museum. If you are carpooling, there will be shared costs for turnpike tolls and gas. If you do not want to be part of the carpool, either meet the rest of the group at the Gibsonia, PA McDonalds on PA Rt. 8 or meet at the museum at the time specified above.

Google Maps lists the driving time from Chardon to the Gibsonia McDonalds as 2 hours 2 minutes. The museum is only a couple minute drive from the McDonalds.
