

Survey Regarding Changing Our Meeting Day/Time In Progress

NOTE: This is only a survey to get your feelings towards changing the MCR Division 5 monthly membership meeting day and time. Before any change would be made, the BOD would discuss this thoroughly, considering input from the membership (such as the results of this survey), and any actual change would require a full membership vote. It would most likely be quite a few months before we would be ready to have the membership vote on any change.

Background: There have been informal discussions over the last few months about changing the day and time of the our monthly membership meeting to something other than a Friday evening. There are members that can't, or do not like to, drive at night and would like to have meetings during daylight hours. This is only a survey to determine the general membership feeling towards this topic.

Pros: More older members may be able to attend meetings in-person. It is often easier to drive during daylight hours, especially during storms. Would be able to hold meetings at libraries for morning and afternoon meetings. Weekends might make it easier for those that have to work late during the week. We are one of the few divisions within our region that meet in the evening.

Cons: Probably will have to find a new meeting location because Hambden Town Hall generally is not available on Saturdays and Sundays due to other events. We have been meeting on Friday evenings for a very long time and everyone is used to it.

A web link was provided in an e-mail to all members with internet access that allows each person to provide their input electronically on the Division 5 website. For those that do not have e-mail and internet access, a paper survey will be mailed to them. The survey will be open until April 9, 2023.

Division 5 Participation Incentives

This is just a reminder about some of the incentives that Division 5 offers to the members for their participation in various Division activities.

Bring & Brag

Members who bring an item to display at the monthly meeting's Bring & Brag receive a \$5 award certify cate. Bring & Brag items must have been completed within the last six months. The member must have put some reasonable amount of modeling effort into the construction or finishing of the item.

Building a model railroad display for public viewing

The Division will award a \$50 certificate to a member who builds a model railroad display and shows it at an NMRA event open to the public. Division funded displays are not eligible for this. The display must be at least 4 square feet in area.

Articles, tips, or pictures for Trainwire

Members that provide items for the newsletter will receive a \$10 award certificate for a one page or longer article, \$5 award certificate for a modeling tip or collection of pictures (5 pictures minimum) covering a relevant railroading activity. The Trainwire editor has final decision over whether the material is used or not. For items to be eligible for an award certificate, the member must have played an active part in generating the information. Thus, submitting an article cut out of the newspaper or a magazine does not qualify.

Clinic or presentation

Members that put on some type of clinic or presentation at a meeting or Division 5 event will receive a \$10 award certificate. The presentation must be at least 20 minutes in length.





