


Suggested a possible Division 5 trip to JL Innovative Designs in Kill Buck, NY. We have a contact within the company that thought they would be open to hosting us.

For items to be eligible for an award certificate, the member must have played an active part in generating the information. Thus, submitting an article cut out of the newspaper or a magazine does not qualify.

Clinic or presentation

Members that put on some type of clinic or presentation at a meeting or Division 5 event will receive a \$10 award certificate. The presentation must be at least 20 minutes in length.



Rails to Pittsburgh 2023 MCR NMRA Convention

The Mid Central Region convention was held on May 4th through May 7th, 2023. As usual, this convention had too much to do and not enough time to do it all. Rich and I arrived at noon on Thursday, and the first order of business was to plug in my T-Trak module. Then we attended the first of many clinics, this one on repurposed trash. In the evening, Rich enjoyed the HO Turtle Creek RR operating session, which featured lots of switching on 189 industrial spurs in 800 sq. ft., while I went to two clinics and then hung out at the T-Trak layout and made new friends. There were 75 modules in the display, with 5 more added on Friday afternoon following the "Make and Take" build a module extra-fare clinic. Two were added next to my sawmill/logging module, which you can see in the photo with the unpainted bases.

Friday and Saturday went very fast: attending clinics, checking out items in the white elephant sale and at the vendors' tables, and admiring the entries in the contest room. We didn't sign up for any rail tours because of time limitations, but I would like to go back to Pittsburgh sometime to go on the "Rivers of Steel" Explorer Riverboat cruise (maybe next year at the National Narrow Gauge Convention). There were 48 clinics presented in three days, with only 3 duplicates. The wide variety of topics provided something for everybody, and there was even a clinic on modeling the future.

Serving as proxy for Matt Kross at the MCR BOD meeting, plus attending a clinic on the future of the NMRA, gave me a different perspective on the MCR membership and the goals of the national organization. Division 5 is doing a good job of meeting their focus on social connectivity and fellowship. We just need more member participation in our activities.

On the way home on Sunday, we visited 5 of the 27 layouts open on the tour. One very large club layout included HO-scale on the main floor and N-scale downstairs. This was an enjoyable long getaway weekend.


