

This is just a reminder about some of the incentives that Division 5 offers to the members for their participation in various Division activities.

Bring & Brag

Members who bring an item to display at the monthly meeting's Bring & Brag receive a \$5 award certificate. Bring & Brag items must have been completed within the last six months. The member must have put some reasonable amount of modeling effort into the construction or finishing of the item.

Building a model railroad display for public viewing

The Division will award a \$50 certificate to a member who builds a model railroad display and shows it at an NMRA event open to the public. Division funded displays are not eligible for this. The display must be at least 4 square feet in area.

<u>Articles, tips, or pictures for Trainwire</u>

Members that provide items for the newsletter will receive a \$10 award certificate for a one page or longer article, \$5 award certificate for a modeling tip or collection of pictures (5 pictures minimum) covering a relevant railroading activity. The Trainwire editor has final decision over whether the material is used or not. For items to be eligible for an award certificate, the member must have played an active part in generating the information. Thus, submitting an article cut out of the newspaper or a magazine does not qualify.

Clinic or presentation


Members that put on some type of clinic or presentation at a meeting or Division 5 event will receive a \$10 award certificate. The presentation must be at least 20 minutes in length.

Anticles

Liz and I visited Colonial Williamsburg at the beginning of August for a week. The first 4 days were spent sightseeing Williamsburg, Yorktown, and Jamestown. We still had another day left so the last day we spent doing some railroad related trips. In the morning we drove up to Tiny Tim's Trains in Ashland, Virginia. It was a well-stocked O gauge train store and I found a rather hard to find Lionel Bluetooth Tower that I plan to incorporate on my module so I can play sound effects and music when we set up at shows. A bonus to this trip was that the train store is about 10 yards from a very active rail line that runs right through the town. While there we had a 5-minute-long CSX train come through as well as 3 Amtrak trains. Tiny Tim's even posted signage as to how to download an app so you know when the trains are coming through town.

The second part of the day we wanted to see some historical train museums or clubs but unfortunately none of them were open on Fridays. What we did run across was the US Army Transpor-


tation Museum in Fort Eustis, Virginia. At first we were concerned that we made a wrong turn as we encountered armed guards stopping us as we drove down the road the GPS had directed us to. We didn't realize that the museum is on an active military base and the guard nicely explained we had to go to this other building first and get checked out before being able to come on base and visit the museum. This museum was not what we expected as it blew away our expectations as to how massive and well-presented all of the displays were set up. If you want to see for yourself and can't visit they have a decent website that shows a small sampling of some of the displays. Just do a google search for US Army Transportation Museum. Unfortunately, we were short on time and didn't really get to spend as much time there (about 90 minutes) as we really needed to take it all in. In addition to the rail artifacts and displays they have almost every imaginable (and some prototypes you couldn't imagine) mode of transportation for guests viewing. If ever in the area we highly recommend planning a visit.

Building my first layout.....First thing, a few words about the layout I am building. It will be completely different than a regular layout. Since I like most railroads and don't want to nail down my modeling to one road or era I chose to model many. Each scene will represent a different railroad in a different location. Right now I am working on the lower level which represents Southeast Ohio along the Ohio River. All the steel mills and 3 different railroads make it interesting. In this scene I have the large Wheeling Pittsburgh Steel plant which dominates the scene along with the USS Steel Ohpawva works. The town in this area is Ohpawva Ohio a play on the abbreviations of the three states in the area Oh Pa and WVA; also in this scene is the Hoyt Clagwell tractor plant, National Steel plant and American Structural Steel plant. I love their slogan "Put some A.S.S. In your next project; this scene can also be Cleveland. I want to get the scenery on before I put the upper level on. The upper level will represent the NYC four track main between Cleveland and Buffalo. More on the other parts of the layout like the helix later. Also on my layout I am adding six cameras in areas that I couldn't possibly access to watch trains like in a building looking out a window or under a bridge or between buildings. I will be able to train watch in these areas on a big screen tv. On the layout I will also have a working overhead crane, operating flare stack. Lights from the electric furnace, etc., there will be 4 working welders on the layout also. I have been adding the cars with the operating headlights and taillights and WOW. More on the layout in the future.
