

BOD Meeting 8 April 2024

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on April 8, 2024. The meeting was held online using Zoom. In attendance were Matt Kross, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Bryan Persing, Mike Carovac, Chuck Limbert, Doug Reidel, John Ward, Bill Osborne, and Ted Wiese.

For now, the Division 5 BOD meetings will remain on the same schedule as they have been. The new Superintendent will need to determine if he wants to change anything around.

The BOD received some preliminary numbers from Railfest 2024. Overall, the results are fairly similar to the 2023 results.

Because the income from Railfest the last few years has been about half of what we had been making, it was discussed whether we should reduce or eliminate giving grants to other model railroad organizations. It was decided that we would keep things as they are since we currently have plenty of reserves.

Railfest 2024 feedback from members has been requested to help with the planning of future Railfests. Chuck Limbert will collect the feedback and put it into a single document. So far, six people have provided their feedback.

Two new members were added in the past month. One full member, Michael Capozzio, and one Rail Pass member, Fred Ondarza.

It was good to see a lot of our new members helping out at this year's Railfest.

There was discussion about how to plan and run Railfest in the future now that Jim Wendorf has retired as Railfest Chairman. The BOD decided that a committee approach would be best. It still needs to be decided how many people will be on the committee but there should be at least three. John Ward has volunteered to lead the committee. He has talked with Jim Wendorf and the two of them will get together to go over all the Railfest details. Others wanting to be involved with Railfest planning may also attend this meeting once a date, time, and location are set. Bryan Persing has volunteered to participate in that meeting. It was suggested that the Railfest Chairman be one of the Division Directors and thus be a BOD member. The BOD needs to define what level of discretion the Railfest Planning Committee will have. Need to decide if we are going to continue to use the P.O. Box as a mailing address. We will need to get the signatures changed on the Railfest checking account when the new people are determined.

Once the new Division officers are in place, we will need to get the signatures changed on the financial accounts.

Now that bank interest rates are back up, we will look at some of the current investment options as possibilities for a portion of our savings.

The continued review of the Division 5 Regulations was tabled until the June meeting.

The next Div 5 BOD meeting will be on Monday, June 10, 2024, at 7:30pm online using Zoom. (Note: Normally, BOD meetings are held on even numbered months from February to October and then in November and not in December.)

AWARDS & RECOGNITION BANQUET

The Convention is capped off on Saturday evening with the Awards & Recognition Banquet. OPERATING SESSIONS

Division 6 of the NMRA Mid-Central Region is currently offering an HO scale 41' gondola lettered for Buckeye Steel Castings.

Buckeye Steel was a large steel foundry located in Columbus, Ohio. They produced castings of numerous railroad components, including trucks, couplers and, the famous "Buckeye Truck." These gondolas moved scrap as well as finished products. Interchange partners included C&O and NYC, both railroads having trackage leading into the plant complex.

These car kits are from Accurail's 3700-series of steel gondolas with road number 23. Decals for six other road numbers are available for those ordering more than one car.

Pricing is \$27 per car. Shipping (via USPS Priority) is \$10 for one car and \$17 for two to three cars. Ohio residents, please add 7.5% sales tax on the total price of the kits and the shipping/handling fee. Customers outside the USA, please contact us for shipping arrangements and charges.
