# **Division 5 Meeting Minutes**

April 1, 2016

The April 1, 2016 membership meeting was called to order by Superintendent Dave Neff at 7:30 pm at Hambden Town Hall. 34 members and 4 guests were present.

**Announcements** included an invitation by the Lake Shore Live Steamers to their September 10<sup>th</sup> club run at the Blueberry Railroad in Geneva, Ohio from noon on. Food will be provided. Other reminders included the Western Reserve Railroad Museum (*Painesville Depot*) fundraiser on April 11<sup>th</sup>, and the NETS swap meet on April 9<sup>th</sup>, KidShow at Great Lakes Mall on April 9-10. The Painesville Depot is going to begin a series of model railroading clinics starting April 2. Clinics will be at 10 am and repeat at 1 pm.

**Jim Wendorf** thanked the approximately 52 people that helped with **Railfest 2016**. We had 106 vendors that brought 410 workers. Public attendance was estimated to be around 3000 for the two days. The gate was down from last year due to it being Palm Sunday and the Dalton show going on the same weekend. There weren't any problems during the show and everything went well. The box lunches continue to be well received. We had 39 people attend the Saturday evening dinner at the Painesville Depot.

It was noted that our **Division storage unit** needs to be cleaned out. There are a lot of items in there that we no longer use.

Members were reminded to send in their election ballots.

Superintendent Neff encouraged members to attend the Mid Central Region convention in Columbus, Ohio at the end of April.

**The Lake Geauga HO Module Group** reported that their setup at Railfest 2016 went very well. They had a number of new modules in the layout and also have several new members. The group received some donations of old buildings. They will use them as give-aways at Lake Farmpark Country Lights in December.

The Lake Erie N-scale Society reported that they had their largest setup in a long time at Railfest 2016. Four people expressed some interest in joining LENS.

Reviewed the plans for the **May membership meeting** in Erie, PA. We will provide pizza, salad, soft drinks, and coffee starting at 6:30 pm. The meeting will start at our regular time of 7:30 pm. The program will consist of several parts. We will have a brief introduction to Division 5 and the NMRA. We will then have a presentation on the Bessemer & Lake Erie Railroad in and around the Erie, PA area. We will be sending out special invitations to people in our new PA and NY counties as well as contacts we obtained at the recent Erie, PA show. Directions and map will be in the May Trainwire.

**Modeling Questions:** How do you attach a ground throw (made of Delrin plastic) to foam or any other base material? The following suggestions were provided.

- 1. Use a thin metal/wood/styrene base then nail/screw ground throw to that base. Glue that base to your layout.
- 2. Use Walthers Goo (*rubber cement type of adhesive*). 3. Use double-sided carpet tape.

How do you adjust the ground throw to properly throw the turnout points? Add shims to hold the turnout points in the center and set the ground throw in its center position. Secure the ground throw and remove the shims.


