

# MINUTES

**Division 5 Membership Meeting Minutes** 

April 7, 2023

The April 7, 2023, membership meeting was held at Hambden Township Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Superintendent Matt Kross. 19 members and 1 guest were present.

- Did a quick review of how Railfest 2023 went. We had lots of people come and help for setup, running the show, and teardown. Thursday setup was excellent. Gate operations went very well. We finished clearing out all the vendors in record time on Sunday night (this was mainly due to three problem vendors not being there this year). The shuttle bus seemed to be better run this year. College personnel were very helpful and responsive. We had 10 more vendors and 25 more tables than last year. Gate revenue was about \$1000 more than last year. We only had about 209 more people attend this year than last year due to the bad snow storm on Sunday morning. Still waiting to see if we get any grant money from the Lake County Visitors Bureau for our event. At the moment, it looks like we made a couple thousand dollars. Next year, we need to work on getting more people to attend. We have raised next year's gate prices by \$1, which will help. The new gate prices are in line with other area shows. We do have the college booked for Railfest 2024 and we are working on getting the college to let us use Gym C in the future. Tables are reserved at Sun Rental for next year.
- We got three new members signed up at our NMRA recruitment table due to the membership discount we offered. Two were a husband and wife where the husband signed up for a full membership and the wife a family membership. The third person joined with a RailPass membership.

Thanks to all those that donated items for Railfest door prizes.

The Div 5 BOD will look at when and where we want to hold our June meeting. Farmpark's Railroads In The Parks event is June 3-4 and many of our members will be involved with setting up layouts for that event on Friday June 2.

Painesville Depot will hold their Model Train Day event on Saturday May 20.

Ohio N-scale Weekend will be May 20-21 in Marysville, OH.

Mid Central Region convention in Pittsburgh is coming up soon on May 4-7.

The Division survey to collect member input regarding changing the monthly meeting day and time ends on Sunday April 9. So far, we have had 35 people out of approximately 55 members provide their feedback. There isn't any clear-cut direction that people want to change to. At the moment, keeping the meeting on Friday evening is slightly in the lead. This will be discussed at the upcoming Div 5 BOD meeting.

#### BOD Meeting 10 April 2023

A Division 5 BOD meeting was held on April 10, 2023. The meeting was held online using Zoom. In attendance were Matt Kross, Bonnie Lette, Wayne Lette, Linda Kacprzak, Dennis Lloyd, Chuck Limbert, Bryan Persing, and Ted Wiese.

- Discussed how the Railfest raffle is run and who is eligible to participate. The BOD did not see any problems with the way things are currently done and so no changes will be made.
- The Railfest Chairman provided a preliminary report to the BOD which listed various numerical and financial results for Railfest 2023 and compared them to Railfest 2022 results.
- We got three new members signed up at our NMRA recruitment table due to the membership discount we offered. Two were a husband and wife where the husband signed up for a full membership and the wife a family membership. The third person joined with a RailPass membership. Also in the past month, we had a previous member decide to rejoin as a RailPass member after dropping out for several years. There are six members who have let their memberships expire during the last several months. Renewal reminders have been sent to those members. One thanked us for reminding him and he will send in his renewal. Another said that they are not going to renew because they no longer feel membership is worth it after the last dues increase.
- Presenters are all lined up for Promo Day 2023. Dennis will meet with the library coordinator to review how the space will be used. We will need to create some new posters for the event.
- Several of our older members have indicated that they either can no longer drive or can't drive at night but would like to come to the meetings if they could get a ride. We will put this in the Trainwire with the Superintendent being the contact. If someone needs a ride, the Superintendent will see if he can find someone that can pick that member up.
- The June membership meeting will be moved back a week from June 2 to June 9 and will be at Hambden Town Hall. The meeting has been moved since the first weekend of June will be the Railroads In Parks event at Lake Farmpark. A number of our members will be involved with setting up layouts at Farmpark on Friday June 2 and not be able to attend a meeting that night.

The Division survey to get feedback from the membership as to whether they are interested and willing to change the monthly membership meeting day/time has now ended. 35 people have responded so far out of about 55 members. The results so far indicate that most people are willing to consider an alternate day/time but the overall preference is to keep it on the first Friday of the month. Coming in at a close second was to have the meeting on a Saturday morning. Some of the members that can no longer drive or have a problem driving at night said they don't have a problem with the Friday evening meetings if they could get a ride to the meeting. For now, we will work on trying to arrange rides for those that want them. The BOD discussed at length the survey results and the comments that have been received. A suggestion is to have another vote/survey with just the top two selections, Friday evening or Saturday morning. Before any further consideration of changing the day/time of the meeting, we need to investigate where we would be able to hold our meetings. Another issue that was brought up is that train shows are on the weekends and so that could affect meeting attendance. There is no clear-cut desire by the membership and there isn't any clear-cut solution to the issue. We don't want to make a change and have meeting attendance drop off. Even with our existing Friday evening meetings, our meeting attendance as a proportion of our membership is actually quite high compared with other divisions and we don't want to mess this up.

Upcoming meetings: we have a program for May. We need a program for June. No meeting in July.

- Bill Osborne has offered to once again host a meeting at his house in the summer for an outdoor train movie night. Due to low attendance at this event in the past, the BOD decided to do this as a special Division event and not a meeting. The Division will provide the refreshments. Bill said he would try to arrange to have some sort of additional mini-program for the evening. Also, since we don't hold a meeting in July, it was suggested that we ask Bill to hold this event on a weekend in July.
- We will have our annual Division Family Picnic again this year. We will see if the Painesville Depot is willing to host this event again, preferably in August.
- Our webmaster has set up storage space on our website for Division electronic documents and software storage. This requires a specific login for each of the different coordinators that have information to store. If someone has data to store, contact the Division 5 webmaster.
- Bill Osborne has volunteered to be the Division Tripmaster. He is looking for ideas on where people would like to go. He would also like to know what the maximum length of time people want a trip to be.
- Need to remind members to use the website to RSVP as to whether they will be attending the meeting for the month.
- The next Div 5 BOD meeting will be on Monday, June 12, 2023 at 7:30pm online using Zoom.

#### **Division 5 Participation Incentives**

This is just a reminder about some of the incentives that Division 5 offers to the members for their participation in various Division activities.

#### Bring & Brag

Members who bring an item to display at the monthly meeting's Bring & Brag receive a \$5 award certificate. Bring & Brag items must have been completed within the last six months. The member must have put some reasonable amount of modeling effort into the construction or finishing of the item.

#### Building a model railroad display for public viewing

The Division will award a \$50 certificate to a member who builds a model railroad display and shows it at an NMRA event open to the public. Division funded displays are not eligible for this. The display must be at least 4 square feet in area.

#### Articles, tips, or pictures for Trainwire

Members that provide items for the newsletter will receive a \$10 award certificate for a one page or longer article, \$5 award certificate for a modeling tip or collection of pictures ( 5 pictures minimum) covering a relevant railroading activity. The Trainwire editor has final decision over whether the material is used or not. For items to be eligible for an award certificate, the member must have played an active part in generating the information. Thus, submitting an article cut out of the newspaper or a magazine does not qualify.

#### **Clinic or presentation**

Members that put on some type of clinic or presentation at a meeting or Division 5 event will receive a \$10 award certificate. The presentation must be at least 20 minutes in length.





Walter "Wally" George Schmunk, III, age 83, passed away peacefully March 16, 2023.



If you go to the My Settings page, you can change the First Name you want to be displayed and used for future logins. Your default First Name is what you supplied to the NMRA on your registration form.


